In another piece of hadith, the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) said, "Jibrail always reminded me to guard the rights of the neighbor until I think a neighbor will inherit his neighbor's property." (Narrated by al-Bukhari No. 5669 and Muslim No. 6854). The Prophet instructed his companions to love the cats as they love their own family. When it comes to celebrating the holidays, celebrating our guests at home, being photographed, dressed in beauty and enjoying a variety of delicious dishes, make sure our pet cat is in a comfortable and safe place. Be sure our cat food has been prepared first.

Cats need a lot of compassion from humans. After getting love and food from his owner, it does not stop giving thanks and will pray for the kindness and generosity of sustenance for his owner. Is not it a loss to the owner when he lost contact with the cat during the Hari Raya? Be aware that cat prayer lasts to the hereafter for its owner.
